<ul> <li>Location/relocation of plumbing</li> <li>System: Pressure-balance or thermostatic</li> <li>Fixtures: Sizes, styles, availability, price</li> <li>Sinks: Undermount or drop-in</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>DESIGN DETAILS</li> <li>Shower seats and niches</li> <li>Extensiveness of tile/stone work</li> <li>Lighting fixture type: pendant/wall sconce/ceiling mount</li> <li>Mirrors: size/style/application</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Lighting type/location, plug locations, switches</li> <li>Impact on existing system capacity</li> <li>Title 24 requirements for kitchens/baths</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Moldings and baseboards (new or match existing)</li> <li>Appliances, art and furnishings to be installed</li> <li>EXTERIOR FINISHES</li> <li>Roofing/rafters/window and door trim</li> </ul>
COMMUNICATIONS, ENTERTAINMENT & SECURITY     New or incorporation into existing systems	<ul> <li>Stucco/wall finish/paint</li> <li>Hardscape/landscape/ighting</li> </ul>

NOTE: For remodels which involve exterior work/additions and the movement of walls/columns/beams, you may also need an Architect or Structural Engineer as well as a site survey and/or geological inspection. Also temporary facilities may be needed on the jobsite.
